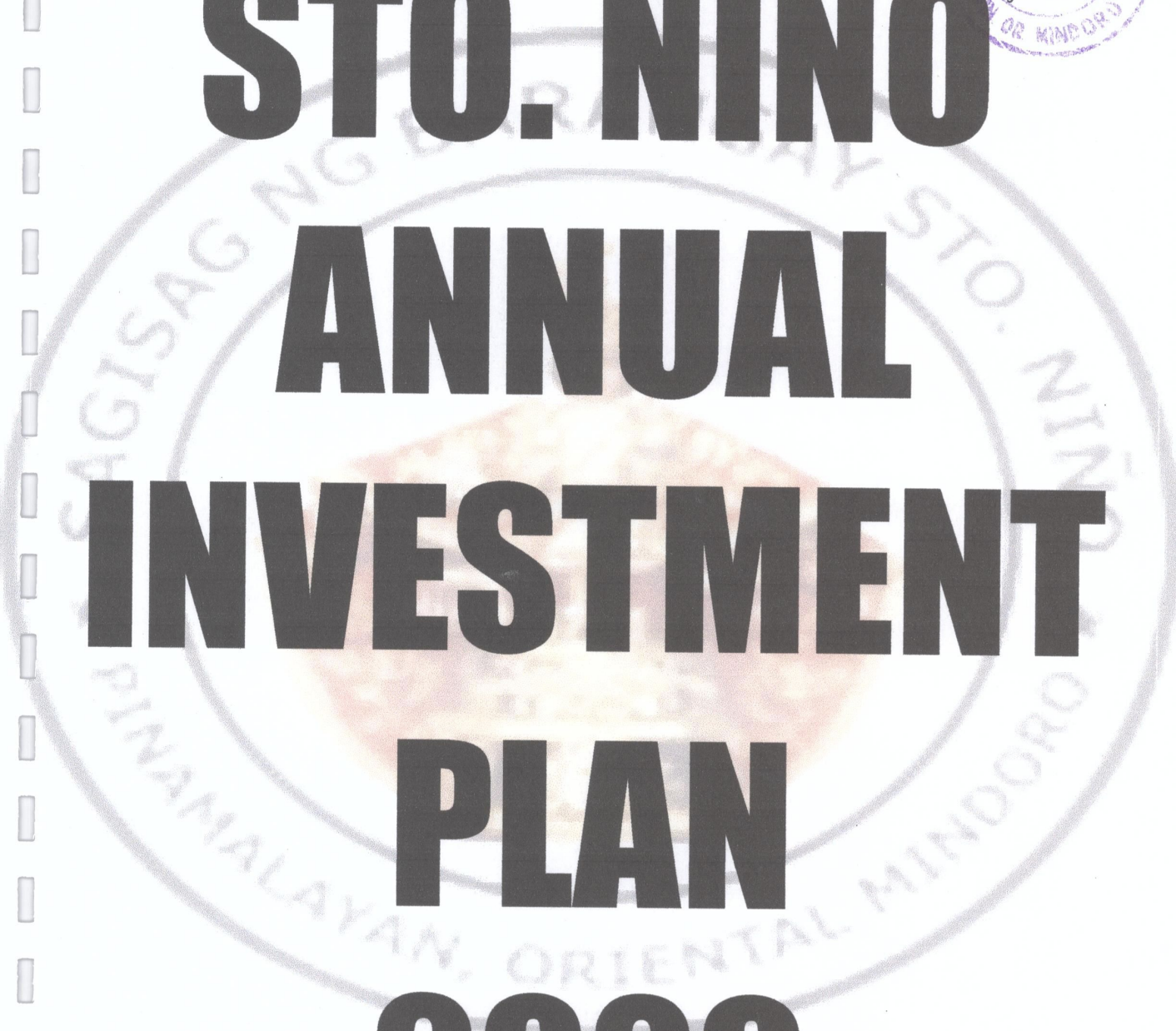
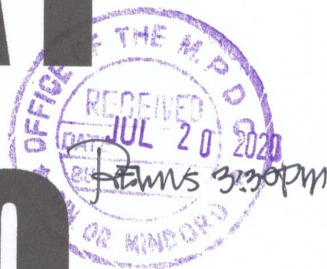

HISTORY OF BARANGAY STO. NIÑO

Barangay Sto Niño was formerly a Sitio Barangay Nabuslot known as Sitio Uyamit, According to the first People in this Barangay it was called Uyamit because it has so many antennae like a Crab, Pagalagala, Bacungan, Bangbang, and Nabuslot but it is better known as Siete because it is seven kilometres away from the town.

It is the first Barangay to reached via the National Highway from the Provincial Capital.

It was separated from the later in the early 80's through the initiative of Mario D. Paylago who was a former municipal administrator in the time of Mayor Emilina L. Baldos. Barangay Sto. Niño was named by the former Mayor. Hon. Emelina L. Baldos

Teodoro Buñag became the 1st Barangay Captain from 1982-1989. He was succeeded by Renato M. Luarca on the Election Held on 1995 by Pacita tan. After one year she resigned and her 1st Councilor Eufrecenio Priela took over her possession as Barangay Captain. Until 1997. And on the election held on 1997. Hector Mascariñas took over his possession. On 2002, Hector Mascariñas was re-elected as Barangay Captain.

On 2007, Election was held and was lost to Ruben L. Sarmiento as Barangay Captain and on 2010 Hector Mascariñas was lost to Ruben. L. Sarmiento.

Election was held again on 2003 Ruben L. Sarmiento won again as Barangay Captain and on 2016 no election was held and all Barangay Officials were hold over up to 2018.

Barangay Sto Niño has seven sitios, Sta. Ana, Gumamela, Rosas, Rosal, Bougainvilla, Violeta, and San Francisco.

This Barangay is Seven Kilometres away from the town proper and two kilometres away from the adjacent town of Socorro sixty-two kilometres away from the capital and is along the highway.

Barangay Sto. Niño has a total population of One Thousand, three Hundred Sixteen(1,316) and has a total number of Household, two-hundred sixty-seven.

An estiamated 90% of the Population were Roman Catholics, and 7% were Seventh Day Adventists and 3% were Iglesia Ni Kristo.

It has an area of 118, 2094 hectares and 3% were Iglesia ni Kristo.

It has an area of 118, 2094 hectares and is fully plain.

The Patron St. of this Barangay is Sto. Niño and Fiesta is celebrated every 3rd Sunday of January.
